
A small but mighty crew hiked Mission Peak: a Rim Rover on October 24, 2105.

Mr. Howard Harrison Castro Valley, CA Founder of Troop 726


Mr. Harrison's Memorial Service was held on the USS Hornet on November 6th, 2015.





Thank you scouts!! There are people out there whose lives are truly affected by these acts of kindness.


Yet not all scouts got the opportunity to see this as not all residents left food! One group of scouts left fliers at 100 houses....






